## Anti-social behaviour in Lightmoor Village

Over the last few weeks a number of reports of anti-social behaviour have been reported to Bournville Village Trust (BVT) and to the Police.

Due to residents concerns, the Safer Neighbourhood Policing Team have increased their patrols of Lightmoor Village, meaning residents will see an additional police presence over the next few weeks. These additional high visibility patrols are for reassurance and are not meant to cause alarm.

## What is anti-social behaviour?

Anti-social behaviour covers a wide range of unacceptable activities that causes harm to an individual, to their community or to their environment. Some examples of anti-social behaviour include issues such as nuisance, rowdy or inconsiderate neighbours, drinking or drug use which leads to nuisance behaviour, abandoned cars or problems with animals.

## What do BVT do about anti-social behaviour?

All reports are taken very seriously. The Stewardship Services and Housing Teams work together with other agencies, such as the Police, to resolve any issues in the most effective way.

## Reporting any issues

If you have witnessed any anti-social behaviour, suspect illegal activity, including the use of cannabis, or have concerns, no matter how small, we would ask you to report it to the Police and to BVT.
